Our April Guest Speaker, Chief Gary Whitson of Cal Fire explained the justifications for the current and upcoming "Defensible Space" requirements. Details are being negotiated, but most homes are going to have trouble meeting the code to be implemented in 2026. In simple terms—no combustible material within 5ft of the house, including sheds, dog houses, and synthetic lawns.

He admitted that he will have to remove the RR tie planters alongside his house.

There are approximately 50,000 structures in Tuolumne County, and his team inspects about 10,000 per year.
